The following is a list of Maine cattle pounds in good or excellent condition, compiled by the Maine Historic Preservation Commission in 2015.

| Town | Directions | Condition |

| Acton (1831) | East side of Milton Mills Road, South Acton. | Good |
| Brooklin | Road side Route 175, on the left side coming from Blue Hill. | Good |
| Charlotte (1826) | Charlotte Road, .25 mile off Route 214; cedar logs. | Good |
| East Corinth | Off Route 15 coming from Bangor, turn left on West Corinth Road. Pound is just to your right after the house on the corner. | Good |
| Greenwood | East side of Twitchell Pond road, 2 miles north of western terminus of Route 219. | Good |
| Harspswell | Harspswell Neck, Harspswell Center, east side of Route 123. | Good |
| Jefferson (1829) | Route 126, about 0.3 miles west of the junction with Route 213, south side of road. | Excellent |
| Lebanon (1813) | Two tenths of a mile, side of Congregational Church, Center Road, west side of road. | Excellent |
| Orrington (1807) | Route 15, west side of road; 0.6 miles north of Orrington Center, near power transmission line, just south of the railroad tracks. Near a small war memorial; rebuilt/cemented. | Excellent |
| Pittston | Off Route 194, on left side of Warren Road. | Good |
| Pownal | Route 9, Bradbury Mountain State Park, west side of road. | Good |
| South Bristol | Rote Farm in Walpole. Pound has big stones. | Good |
| Turner | Intersection of General Turner Hill and Kennebec Trail, Route 219 West, left on Plains Road, goes into General Turner Hill Road. Pound is on right side, across from Bradford Road. | Excellent |
| Waldoboro (1819) | Near Historical Society, Route 220, west side of road. Just south of junction with Route 1. | Excellent |
| Waterboro (1824) | Ossipee Hill Road, north side of road, .5 mile west of Route 5. | Good |
